APPLIANCE REPAIR



As an Appliance Repair Technician, you will work to repair, adjust, or install all types of electric or gas home appliances, such as refrigerators, washers, dryers, and ovens.

DAY IN THE LIFE



In this job, you will work mostly in homes or in a shop, and may be called in emergency situations at any time of day or night if immediate repairs are needed. For regularly scheduled work, you may be required to frequently work early mornings and other irregular hours. However, most appliance repair technicians will work around 40 hours per week.



Repair work is rather safe, but injuries can happen with exposure to electrical parts. You may also be required to carry heavy appliances regularly, so it is recommended for people in this line of work to be in good physical condition.
